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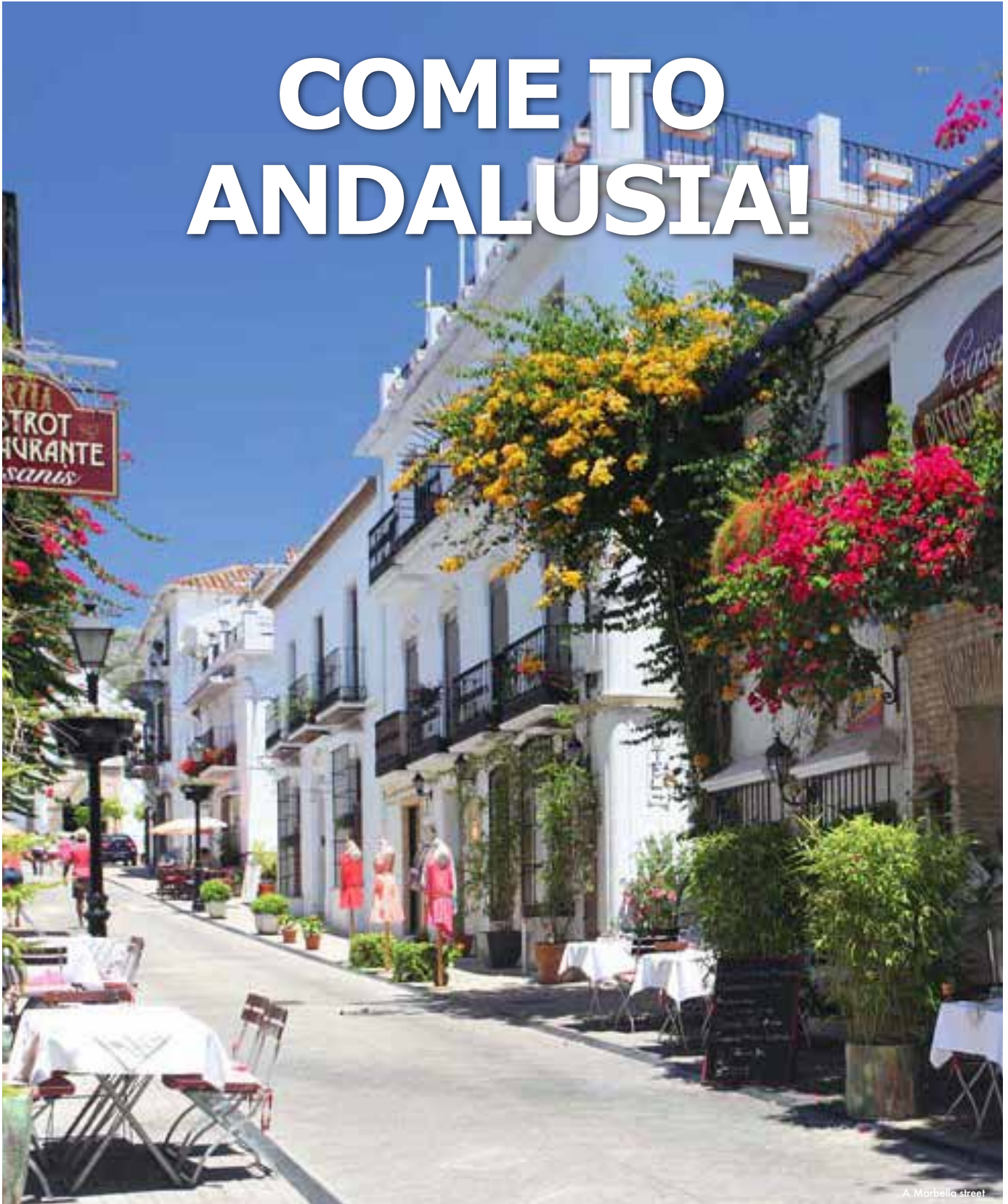

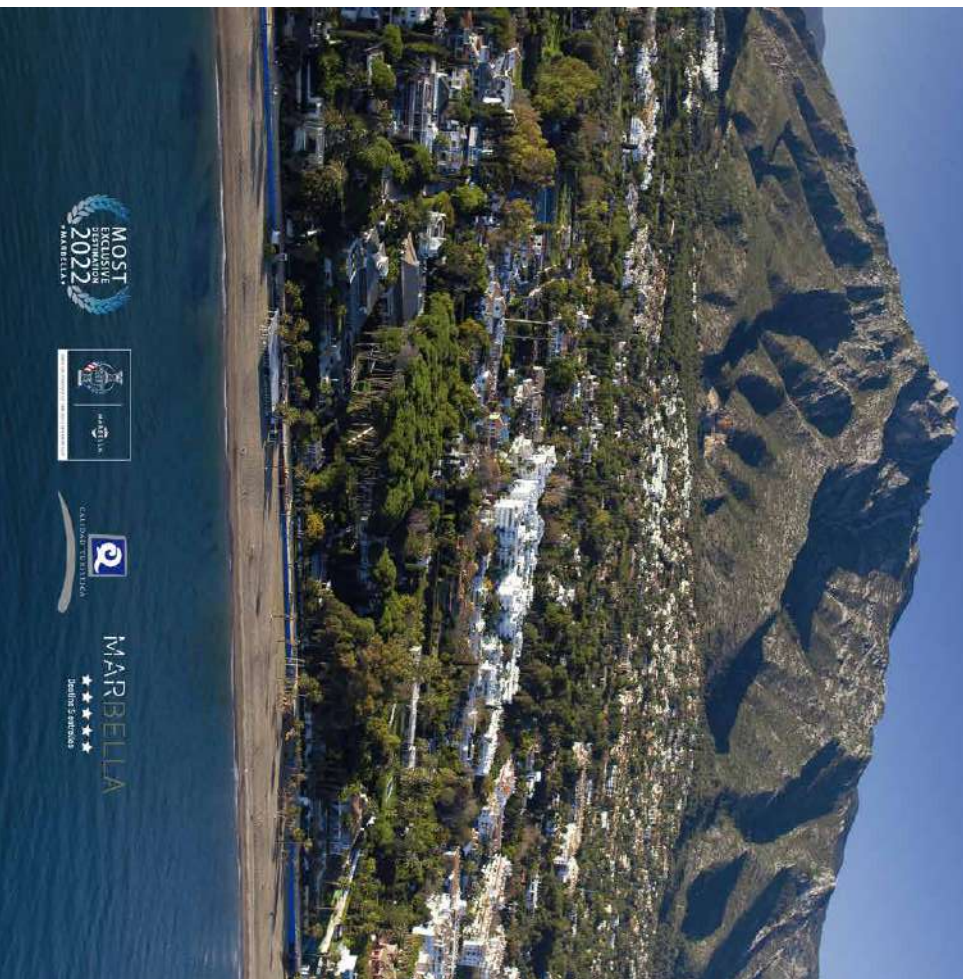

The King of Spain delivers the trophy at the Solheim Cup held in Costa del Sol Andalusia

His Majesty the King of Spain, Felipe VI, was in charge of presenting the trophy to the winning team of the edition of the Solheim Cup which was played on the Costa del Sol with the support of the Juan Manuel Herreró Bonilla, president of the Andalusian Government, of Andalus and your Minister of Tourism and Sports, Arturo Bernal from the Mayor of Marbella, María Angeles Muñoz and other institutions.

The presence of the King of Spain reinforced the support of the Royal Family for one of the most important golf competitions in Europe and the USA.

Queen Letizia has held the position of Honorary President of the Solheim Cup 2023 since it was announced that it would be held for the first time in Spain.

The King had the opportunity to follow some of the matches played on the Frica Cortesin golf course, before presiding over the closing ceremony of the Solheim Cup and presenting the trophy to the winning team.

The duel between the USA and European teams was decided by a single point in favor of Europe, achieved by the Spanish leader Carita Ciganda.

The Solheim Cup is a biennial golf tournament for professional women golfers contested by teams representing Europe and the United States. It is named after the Norwegian-American



golf club manufacturer, Karsten Solheim, who was a driving force behind its creation.

NOT JUST ANY TROPHY

The Solheim Cup trophy that the European and US teams fought at Frica Cortesin is a crystal glass made by the prestigious firm Waterford Crystal. Weighing just over nine kilos, the cup measures almost half a metre in height (49 centimeters exactly), including the masonry base, and has a diameter of almost 11.50 at the top and almost 21 at the bottom. In addition, the central area of the trophy is occupied by an oval with the Solheim Cup name and the silhouette of the cup.

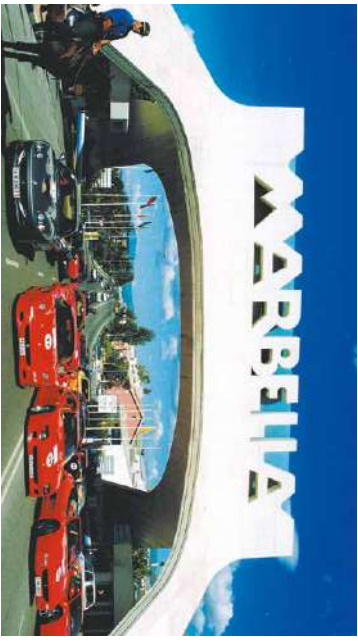

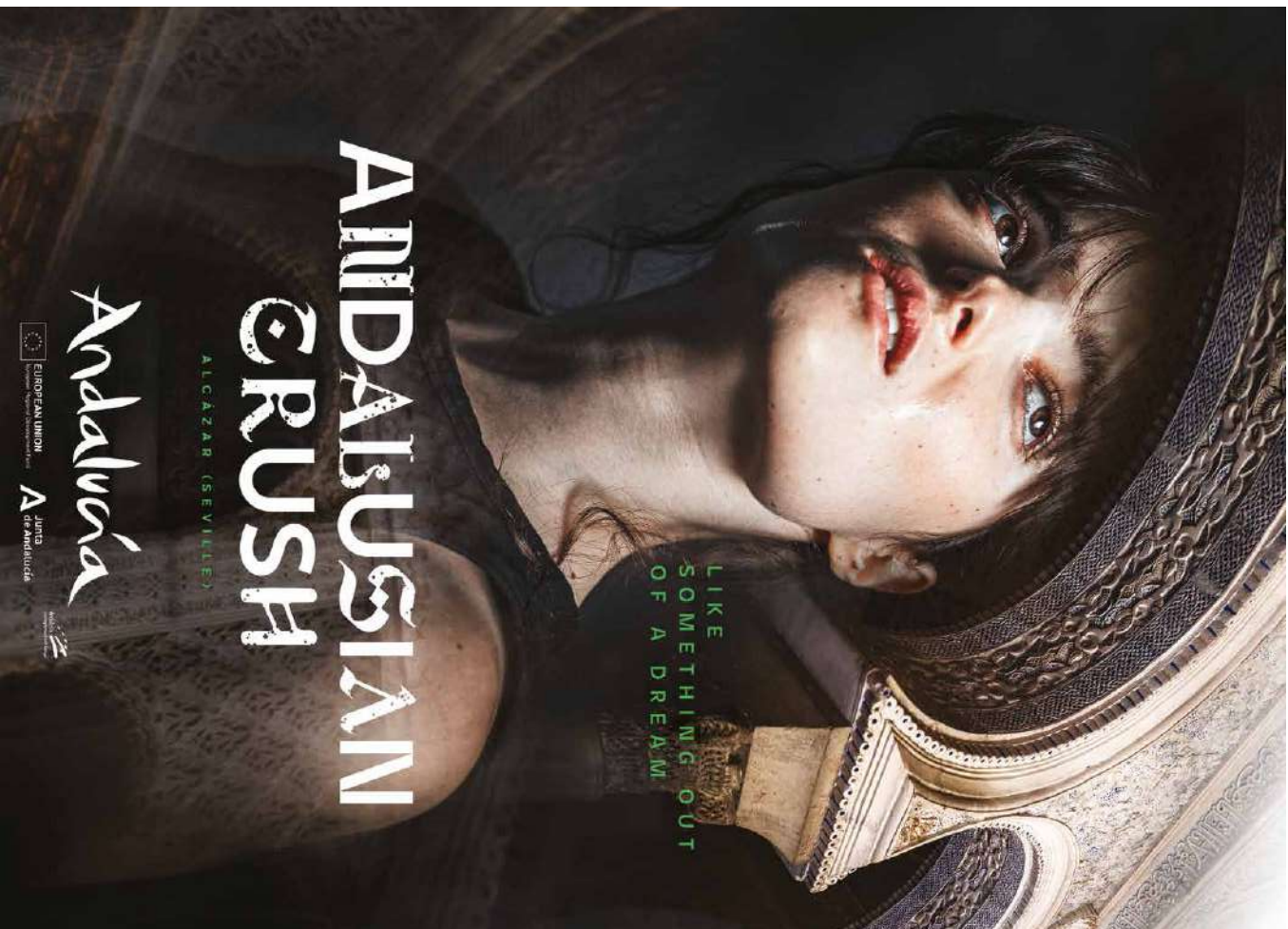
Seminal to Marbella is an exemplary model for the hospitality trade, with a significant concentration of the luxe hotels, five-star hotels and four-star hotels and around 800 restaurants serving cuisines from around the entire world. Without forgetting the four Michelin starred restaurants.

Shopping facilities in Marbella are the most outstanding in Spain, a wide range of international brands and boutiques, as well as famous shopping centres have all served to turn the city into a paradise of distinction and shopping pleasure.

Just 9 kilometres west of Marbella centre, San Pedro Alc tara has got many attractive places, such as the Centre, a pedestrian area full of charm with well-maintained streets that offer you any type of services and shops, the modern boulevard the Avenida del Mediterr neo, the Paseo Maritimo (seaside) and its beaches. Of note are its Parish Church, El Ingenio Cultural Centre, the Tapiche de Guadiza Cultural Centre, the Roman Baths of Guadalmina and the Paleo-Christian Basilica of Vega del Mar.

The Roman Villa of Rio Verde, close to Puerto Banus, deserves a special mention. And finally, Puerto Banus, named after its developer Jos  Banus, 6 km west of Marbella, considered to be one of the most remarkable marinas on the Spanish coastline. It opened in 1970 with 915 berths for some of the most luxurious boats from around the world. Its famous marina and magnificent selection of bars, restaurants and international boutiques make it a glamorous and charming place for all those who visit it.





Torremolinos: the endless summer

Torremolinos is a friendly city, open 365 days a year with an offer that perfectly balances enjoyment on the beach with exploring nature, given the proximity of the mountains and unique places such as La Cañada del Lobo. Large open spaces where you can practice sports, enjoy nature and reconnect with yourself. A diverse place, where gastronomy is an ancient art that finds a thousand and one stops here. A paradise that, preserving the essence of its past, that of the origin of the tourism industry, is renewed with much more enjoyable places.

SMART PARADISE
Torremolinos has decided to reinvent itself, and it does so hand in hand with intelligence and sustainability, so that it is better integrated into its environment and

creates spaces of enjoyment for its neighbors and its many visitors, installing urban elements that improve energy efficiency and give place to shaded spaces. Torremolinos wants to be a low emission zone, controlling the volume of traffic and giving priority to pedestrians to improve their traffic and mobility. As part of this project, La Nogalera stands out, which will be the result of a comprehensive comprehensive reform, turning this municipal space of the city into a much friendlier and greener place and connected to other streets in its surroundings.

SPORTS PARADISE
Torremolinos is an ideal place to practice Windsurfing, Paddle Surfing and Beach Volleyball. Kayak, Swimming, Trip or Rafting, and that looks towards the sea and embraces it not only as a source of sustenance, but as a place of enjoyment. The proximity of mountain systems that are part of the municipality itself make Torremolinos an ideal place to carry out walks in the middle of nature, a calisthenics exercise circuit, or hiking with up to three official hiking routes: the Camino del Agua, the Cañada del Wolf and the Great Path. Urban sports are in every corner of the city, with green areas and parks where you can practice outdoor: Crossfit, cycle tourism, running, triathlon, or road races.

SPACES CONVERTED INTO CULTURE
The cultural life that has experienced a real upheaval in recent months gives impetus to scenic and cultural spaces, such as the Pablo Ruiz Picasso Cultural Center or La Casa de los Naufragos, in the neo-Mudéjar style from the early twentieth century, or the creation of new spaces at the service of culture, such as the Mirador de San Juan, a tribute to the authors of the Generation of 27. And it will have its own cultural brand around La Nogalera, with a specific programming that will turn this square into a meeting place, leisure and reflection.

ACCESSIBLE BY LAND, SEA OR AIR

You can reach the Rock in under 3 hours flying time from the United Kingdom. Given the advantage of its compact size, many attractions are reachable on foot. Trains fer time from landing at Gibraltar International Airport to arrival at your hotel is swift.

SYMBOL OF GIBRALTAR

The Rock of Gibraltar is often characterised by its Barbary macaques who became a symbol of Gibraltar's Britishness during the Second World War, and whose numbers were increased on the command of Prime Minister Winston Churchill today, the macaques can be spotted at various points on the Upper Rock.

A haven for nature and wildlife, Gibraltar is packed with appeal for tourists of all ages. Exploring the Upper Rock Nature Reserve offers

the visitors an array of hidden gems, among them St Michael's Cave with its awe-inspiring stalagmites and stalactites and its natural auditorium that is used to stage events.

GREAT SIEGE TUNNELS

The Great Siege Tunnels form part of the home-combed inside of the Imposition Rock and were funded during the late 1700s and 1800s. The story of their construction is one of bravery, defiance and courage which have come to define Gibraltar's legacy today; the tunnel system was further developed during the Second World War. Visitors can see where servicemen assembled Spitfire planes from inside the Rock ready to assist the war.

MAIN STREET

Back in town, Main Street is at the centre of life in Gibraltar and runs across the length of the historic centre. Buzzing with life, the streets are filled with the air of a café society, against a backdrop of fusion architecture, a mix of Mediterranean, Moorish and British Regency styles.

Gibraltar is a VAT free jurisdiction and offers great value shopping. The Gibraltar Pound is equivalent to UK Sterling. Best buys include cosmetics and perfumery, jewellery, tobacco and spirits, designer glass frames, specialist mens and electronics. Other attractions accessible

from the town centre include the Thrill Seekers Trail. At 71 metres long, it is located between two batteries and connected over a 50 metre gorge. Further along the trail is Skywalk. Standing 340 metres directly above sea level, Skywalk is higher than the tallest point of London's Shard and offers breathtaking 360 degree views spanning three countries and two continents.

RESTAURANTS

Gibraltarians love food, and there is an abundance of restaurants and districts to choose from the excitement of Casenates Square to the laidback and glittery environments of Gibraltar's two stylish marinas, Queensway Quay and Ocean Village which between them offer lively restaurant, bars and an international casino.

Take a boat tour from one of the marinas into the Bay to catch sight of one of three species of dolphin that inhabit Gibraltar's waters. Strolling in another popular pastime with sailing schools and boat hire companies on offer.

Like the Rock itself, Gibraltar's coastline is full of historical content. Gorham's Cave remains the

last known site of Neanderthal survival, some 28,000 years ago! A tour takes visitors by sea to the site of an original Moorish bathhouse in Bomb House lane, the serenity of the Alameda Botanic Gardens developed in 1816 and which is higher than the Gibraltar Wildlife Park, a centre for rescued animals.

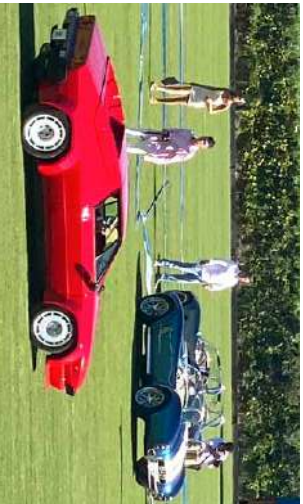

Gibraltar hosts an active calendar of sporting and cultural events, together with a series of international festivals.

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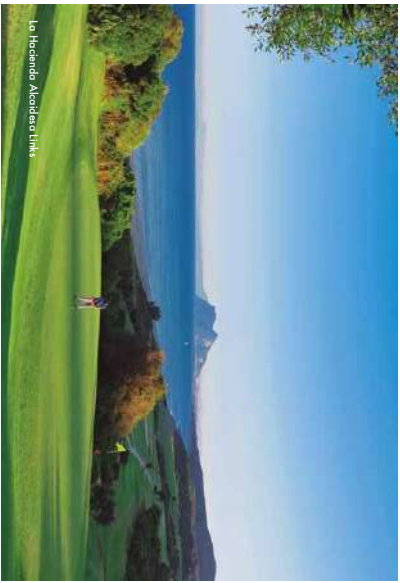
Destination San Roque

San Roque is situated between two continents: Europe and Africa, where the Mediterranean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean meet. The City of San Roque is set in the Straits of Gibraltar, next to the mythical Pillars of Hercules, in the southern most point on the Iberian Peninsula. It is a crossroads where diverse cultures have intermingled.

The borough of San Roque is an environmentally sustainable, high-quality tourist destination. The municipality offers visitors a wide range of tourist facilities including 7 golf courses, 11 polo fields, a marina, an impressive collection of listed historical buildings, traditional festivities such as Holy Week (an Event of Andalusian Tourist Interest) and the Royal Fair, as well as several nature spots covering large surface areas and three blue-flag beaches.

THE HISTORICAL CENTRE

The old quarter of town was declared a Collection of listed historical buildings in 1973. The most notable monuments in the city are Saint Mary the Crowned Parish Church (1735), the Governor's Palace (18th century) and the Bull Ring (1850), the se-



cond oldest one in the province of Cadiz and one of the oldest in Andalusia. The most picturesque streets are San Felipe (central) and Nicosia and Historidor's Home (to the most emblematic square Plaza de Armas in which the Royal Cape and Sword Technique (modern bullfighting) was in-

vented in 1720. The city offers three museums at present: Cartra Archaeological Museum, Luis Ortega Bot Sculpture & Iconography Museum and the bullfighting history.

EUROPEAN GOLF CAPITAL

In the Sotogrande area you will find the Valderrama Golf Club, world famous for having been the only venue on European Continental soil for the 1997 mention of the Ryder Cup, next to the American Express World Championship or Volvo Masters Tournament, venue from 1986 until 1996 and from 2002 to 2008 and the Andalusia Masters.

Many consider San Roque to be the European Golf Capital as the borough can boast of having nine golf courses. In addition, three of San Roque's golf courses are in the European Top 50 golf courses: Valderrama (number one), Real Club de Golf Sotogrande (number two) and San Roque Club Old Course (number thirty-five).

The borough has a total of 180 holes at present. La Hacienda Alcaidesa Golf Club with 27 holes, the San Roque Club with 27 holes, the San Roque Club Old Course with 27 holes, the San Roque Club New Course with 18 holes, Alcaidesa Headland with 18 holes, Reserva de Sotogrande with 18 holes, San Roque Club New Course with 18 holes and the previously mentioned Valderrama, also with 27 holes.

It is also the only one in the world that organises two international circuit tournaments, the Gold and Silver Cups.

The sport attracts over 50,000 spectators per annum to the 7 polo fields run by the aforementioned club and 25/30ah Polo Club.

Above all, the Texas tournament's Gold Cup is the highlight of the summer season.

The Santa Maria Polo Club's facilities are located in 3 areas of San Roque's most prestigious residential area, Sotogrande and its surroundings: Los Pinos (fields II, III and IV) and Puente de Héro (fields II and III). Avial Polo Clubs polo grounds are located at Hacienda de San Enrique.

Marina Sotogrande features 132 moorings and is the largest marina in Andalusia. Nautical sports, fishing, whale watching and coastal cruises are just a few of many possibilities that this port has to offer and is situated within the Borough of San Roque's most prestigious resort. The Royal Yacht Club organises high level regatta competitions in the Sotogrande Port where the most qualified sailors from Spain compete.
